**Genesis** - *Moses*

"In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth." - Genesis 1:1

**Job** - *Job*

"For I know that my Redeemer lives, And He shall stand at last on the earth;" - Job 19:25

**Exodus** - *Moses*

"I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. You shall have no other gods before Me." - Exodus 20:2-3

**Leviticus** - *Moses*

"Love your neighbor as yourself. I am the Lord." - Leviticus 19:18

**Numbers** - *Moses*

## David and Solomon (1000 – 931 B.C.):

**2<sup>nd</sup> Samuel** - *Samuel or Ezra*

"The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer;" 2 Samuel 22:2

**Proverbs** - *Solomon*

"Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths." - Proverbs 3:5

**Ecclesiastes** - *Solomon*

"There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens." - Ecclesiastes 3:1

**Song of Solomon** - *Solomon*

"I am my beloved's, and my beloved is mine." - Song of Solomon 6:3

## Rehoboam to Hezekiah (931 – 686 B.C.):

**Isaiah #23** - *Isaiah*

**Hosea** - *Hosea*

**Joel** - *Joel*

"And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions." - Joel 2:28

**Amos** - *Amos*

"But let justice roll on like a river, righteousness like a never-failing stream!" - Amos 5:24

**Obadiah** - *Obidiah*

"But on Mount Zion will be deliverance; it will be holy, and Jacob will possess his inheritance." - Obadiah 1:17

**Jonah** - *Jonah*

But I will sacrifice to You With the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay what I have vowed. Salvation is of the Lord." - Jonah 2:9

### **Micah** - *Micah*

"He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God." - Micah 6:8

## **Hezekiah to the exile (686 – 586 B.C.):**

### **Nahum** - *Nahum*

"The Lord is good, a refuge in times of trouble. He cares for those who trust in him." - Nahum 1:7

### **Habakkuk** - *Habakkuk*

"Though the fig tree does not bud and there are no grapes on the vines, though the olive crop fails and the fields produce no food, though there are no sheep in the pen and no cattle in the stalls, yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will be joyful in God my Savior." - Habakkuk 3:17-18

### **Zephaniah** - *Zephaniah*
